- Attend regular school council meetings.

- Act as a tour guide for visitors to Bolder Academy.
- Work with peers to develop student voice.
- Feedback peer views at school council meetings.
- Present peer views at SLT meetings.
- Nominate and select Jack Petchey Award winners.
- Wear a high visibility vest when carrying out, so you are visible to your peers and teachers when carrying out duties.
- Write updates on the achievements and progress of the school council for the school newsletter.
